**Composite Scores:** The above composite scores include reading, language arts, math, sources of information, social studies, and science.

**Grade Equivalent:** These are used to determine a student's developmental status or year to year growth. The grade equivalency indicates the grade level at which the typical student has obtained the raw score.

**National Percentile Ranking:** These scores tell the percent of students in a particular group that received lower raw scores on a test than the student did.

**Analysis:** Most of our class composite scores are in the top quartile. This indicates that the curricular program at St. Francis Xavier promotes the high achievement of our students. In addition, the scores reflect a minimum of a year's growth with some up to a year and 9 months for each class. We will continue to use these results to guide us in or on-going effort to develop and improve our school programs.
