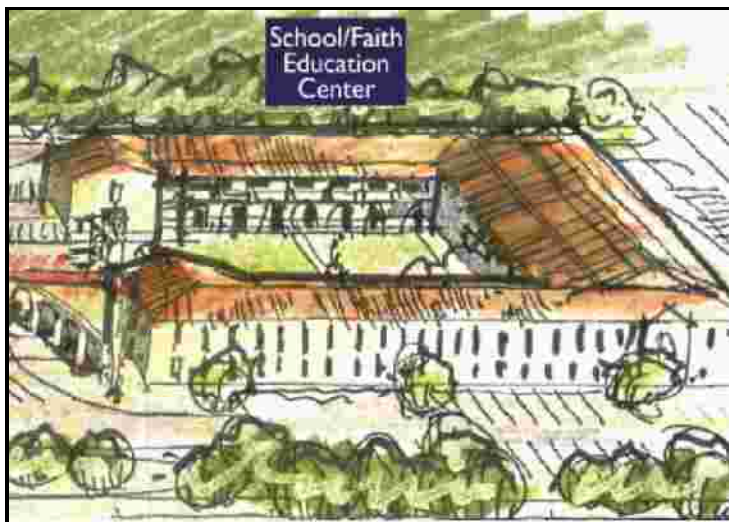

## St. Francis Xavier Master Plan – Part 1

A new two-story School/Faith Education Center will be built to house all youth related educational programs, including our Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade school and Religious Education classes. The current school facilities - built in the 40's and 50's - are simply inadequate to meet the educational and spiritual needs of the youth we prepare for the future.



Today, learning styles, teaching styles and technology demands are more advanced and require revamping. The new school buildings will be 50% larger than the current school facilities; it will open to the west to provide a visual and symbolic connection to the church.

An increase in size does not equate to an increase in our student population in each classroom.

The southwest corner will house a junior high tournament sized multi-use gym/cafeteria. Other activity zones include the play structure area, the hard court play area and the grass play areas which will be fenced for security. With the new construction, the school will be in closer proximity to the existing athletic fields.

In addition to housing St. Francis Xavier School (Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade), this structure will also house both of our Religious Education programs, one utilizing the Montessori Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and the other more traditional method specifically for our Spanish-speaking households.
